 Roundtables are open conversation and discussion sessions or press conferences that are directly embedded in your company profile. An ideal format for sharing custom content and increasing your reach.

 The booking process has to be done for each roundtable individually, i.e. each roundtable gets its own title and description. You have received an e-mail with the following data for this purpose:

Click on the "Book Session" button to select an appointment slot and access the filling mask to maintain the information for your session. Save this mail to book multiple slots if you have purchased more than one.

- Part of the **PREMIUM and EXCLUSIVE exhibitor packages** or can be booked separately in the Online ExhibitorShop.
- Visible in your company profile as well as in the general agenda (public)
- Time limit: max. 30 min.
- Number of participants: max. 40 persons per roundtable
- Roundtables are designed and chaired by yourself (excluded are topics that have conference character or are tangential to conference topics)

Technical implementation with **standard tool Jitsi**, which is integrated into the platform

It is possible to integrate other common tools such as MS Teams or Zoom; for this, the **link must be provided by you**;

The exhibitor must play back his own recording via screen sharing.

Participation in a Roundtable is quite simple. On the platform, there is a category called "Roundtables" in the agenda. Click on this category and click on "Participate" for the roundtable you want. This will then be saved directly in your calendar.
