

Technical requirements and Jitsi

- Take a look at this overview of all the important **technical requirements** for the platform and also feel free to forward this information to your IT in the run-up to the event.
- IMPORTANT: Test the Jitsi communication tool in advance: <u>https://08.meet.talque.com</u>

<u>Tip</u>: grab colleagues from the environment and start a test call - the tool is the basis for all 1:1 video calls or direct video calls on the platform.

If your company's firewall prevents you from using the tool, you can have Jitsi activated by your IT department!

With Jitsi, it is recommended to share videos via links in the chat instead of playing them directly via screen sharing - the quality may be somewhat reduced otherwise. <u>Notes</u>: In Jitsi, NO virtual backgrounds can be set. Jitsi is the communication tool for all direct video calls and 1:1 or group calls. For Roundtables, there is the possibility to integrate other common tools like Zoom or MS Teams.

- In order to give you the chance to test also within the platform with **Jitsi** already before the runtime of embedded world, the **call function** is already activated for everyone from 25 February, 2021. This gives you the chance to test live video calls within the platform in advance as well. By the way, **you do not need your own account to use Jitsi**.
- **Browsers:** Preferably, use **Microsoft Edge**, **Safari** and **Google Chrome**, as other browsers may not fully support the platform. The use of Firefox is possible, but not recommended.
- Our personal tip: save **the platform as a favourite**, then you have easy access at any time!
- It is possible to synchronize your Google or Outlook **calendar** with the calendar of events of your own appointments on the platform; appointment requests can also be sent to you by e-mail.
