The hygiene concept for the Nuremberg exhibition center Safe - Transparent - Practical - Incidence-independent



We are in close exchange with the authorities -> hand in hand for safe events.

> 3G access concept for all participants of BIOFACH / VIVANESS 2022 (exhibitors, professionals, visitors...)

> Distance

- 1.5 m from other people
- Waiting areas (Community areas) in the halls
- More space in the entrance area and wide corridors in the halls
- Crowd management by hygiene scouts at the event

> Hygiene

- Increased cleaning / disinfection in critical areas
- Additional disinfection facilities on the area

> Masks

- Indoor masks mandatory Medical face mask of all participants
- The mask obligation does not apply at a fixed sitting, standing or working place, as long as a minimum distance of 1.5 m to other persons is reliably maintained or an effective spit shield (hygiene protection wall) is set up between the persons, e.g. during counselling talks at the stand.
- Outdoor masks only if distance 1.5 m cannot be maintained

> Optimized ventilation

- Air exchange rate depending on the building 6 10 times per hour
- Fresh air is filtered

3G-access concept

Your admittance to the event

All groups of people with a valid e-ticket who have been verifiably vaccinated, recovered or tested (3G-status) can participate in the event.

This is how it works:

Advance registration

Register in the online ticket shop and if applicable, upload a QR code certificate* to activate the ticket for direct access to the exhibition.

Entry control at the entrance

or with e-ticket plus approved OR code certificate* via double scan

waiting time must be planned

*approved QR code certificate via EU Green Certificate, Coronavirus Warning App,

CovPass-App, Luca-App (others under review)

Fast Lane

Only for activated ticket holders via one-time scan

Clearing Lane

Emergency testing capacities available on site >

On-site safety instructions



1.5 meter safety distance

NÜRNBERG / MESSE



Hand hygiene (washing and disinfecting)



Follow the rules for coughing and sneezing

Face covering



No shaking hands or hugging



Use contactless payment whenever possible

Valid admission certificates (3G-certificates)

Vaccinated*:

- Proof of complete vaccination more than 14 days ago
- · Valid are analog vaccination certificates and digital vaccination certificates with a vaccine approved in the EU

Recovered*:

- Positive PCR test with date (at least 28 days ago, but not longer than six months ago)
- · Or official guarantine order (not more than six months ago) together with a later negative test

Tested*:

- · Negative test result (Antigen test not more than 24 hours ago; PCR test not more than 48 hours ago)
- · Self tests are not permitted

Children and teenagers:

- · Children under 14 years of age may only visit the event if accompanied by adults. Registration is not required. Admittance can be gained via the service entrances.
- · Children six years old and older must present a negative PCR or antigen test or proof of recovery.
- · Teenagers 14 years old and older may only visit the event after registration and with their own ticket and 3G-certificate.

3G-access concept

Vaccinated - Recovered - Tested -> High security for all participants Perfectly implemented through intelligent ticket stores

CovPass-App

- Official APP of the RKI
- QR Code available at vaccination center or in pharmacies

> EU Green Certificate

- Vaccination certificates, test certificates (NAAT/RT-PCR test or rapid antigen test)
- Certificates for people who have recovered from COVID-19

Corona Warn-App (CWA)

- same principle as the CovPass App
 - QR code is scanned with the smartphone camera and stored in the app.

➤ Luca – App

- same principle as the CovPass App and Corona-Warn-App

Medical care

- Entrance only possible for healthy people
- Medical staff on site (also during set-up and dismantling)

Contactless payment on site

Additional measures on the site

- Informing all trade fair participants about necessary hygiene measures
- Installation of waiting areas (Community Areas) in the entrance area and in the halls
- Even distribution of visitors over all days of the fair
- Gangway widening in the halls

Tickets

- mandatory contact data collection of all visitors and professionals
- the daily quota for BIOFACH / VIVANESS is 50,000 visitors
- Tickets bookable online only

Corona protection measures for exhibitors, service providers, professionals



The health of our professionals is close to our hearts

- > Full application of the current SARS-COV2 occupational health and safety regulation of the BMAS https://www.bmas.de/DE/Service/Gesetze-und-Gesetzesvorhaben/sars-cov-2-arbeitsschutzverordnung.html
 - Entrepreneurs design their occupational health and safety measures for their personnel on the basis of the nationally applicable occupational health and safety measures
 - 3G-obligation for all participants at BIOFACH / VIVANESS 2022
- > Contact data collection of professionals through digital registration of exhibitor passes and STP
 - Exhibitor passes as usual via the TicketCenter
 - Registration app (STP) for service providers, e.g. forwarding agents etc.

> Assembly and dismantling

- The SARS-COV2 occupational health and safety standard for professionals also applies here -> entrepreneurs determine
 the protective measures
- Contact data collection through digital registration for the body passes

Stand catering



New opportunities through differentiation

> General "office situation", e.g. coffee, tea, soft drinks, water, meeting cookies....

- No additional contact data collection required
- The mask obligation does not apply at a fixed sitting, standing or working place, as long as a minimum distance of 1.5 m to other persons is reliably maintained or an effective spit shield (hygiene protection wall) is set up between the persons, e.g. during counselling talks at the stand.

> Catering on booth, serving food, e.g. sandwiches, cakes, salads, snacks....

- Masks can be removed at the seat
- Service at the seat
- QR code scan = contact data capture
- Adherence to gastro-hygiene rules for serving staff (leaflet currently being prepared)
- Please refrain from self-service offerings at booth catering. Food and beverage should only be served by service staff behind glass or acrylic glass (available at the event's trade show store) or by serving at the seat. Dishes, cutlery, napkins, etc. should also be handed out by service personnel
- Self-service is possible with packaged food and closed beverage bottles

> Current general conditions are still being clarified

Stand construction





Stand planning

- To enable as many people as possible to visit exhibition stands at the same time, stand designs should allow for plenty of space, with minimal structures.
- It must be possible to observe minimum distancing at all times and this can be ensured, for example, by floor markings, room dividers or "traffic light" systems.
 If it is not possible to maintain a minimum distance in particular locations, other measures may be put in place, such as sneeze guards on meeting tables and counters.
- Avoid unnecessary narrow spaces or gathering areas (e.g. in front of exhibits or presentations) and make sure exhibits at your stand have enough open space around them. Ensure that your stand design allows for the aisles around it to be kept free, e.g. avoid placing product information right at the boundary between the stand and the aisle.



Meeting areas

- In meeting areas, the seating distance between tables and chairs must be arranged to ensure the participants remain at least 1.50 metres apart.
- If it is not possible to maintain a minimum distance in particular locations, other measures may be put in place, such as sneeze guards or screens in seating areas.
- Hygiene protection screens may be used at the information counter and other counters if it is not possible or practical to maintain a minimum distance of 1.50 metres.

Stand construction





Small stand areas

- Minimum distancing is not essential if sneeze guards are in place on the meeting tables and counters. In such cases, however, people on both sides of the guard must wear masks.

 This means smaller stands can be designed with a range of meeting options.
- 2 If room separators or sheets of acrylic glass are not practicable, exhibitors must limit the numbers of visitors to their stands.
- Note that if it is not possible to arrange waiting areas by your stand, your visitors must not wait in the aisles, since it is essential to keep these areas free to maintain minimal social distancing.
- We recommend you make firm appointments with your customers or move to a different area for unplanned meetings (e.g., a catering area or special Community Areas, if available).



Two-level stand construction

- If two-level stands are permitted at an exhibition, ensure at the design stage that staircases are sufficiently wide, or make provisions for one-way movement.
- If an upper level is in place, ensure that the lower area has an open layout and that an adequate air exchange can be guaranteed.

Stand assembly and disassembly

- Distancing and hygiene rules may lead to delays in assembling and disassembling your stand.

 We recommend you make full use of the time available at the event for assembly and disassembly.

 Be sure to work out your timing in detail, and if possible stagger the different activities involved to ensure smooth workflows.
- Ensure all service providers you engage, e.g. stand construction companies, carriers, agency employees, technical services, etc., register in advance and carry an assembly/disassembly pass.

 If they do not hold such a pass they will be required to register on-site.

 Please advise your stand construction company of these conditions as appropriate.


